





School of Nursing and Student Community Center




The School of Nursing and Student Community Center (SONSCC) Building is home to our nationally ranked Nursing School and is the only "green" building in the Texas Medical Center.

SONSCC won the Citation of Honor from the American Institute of Architects-Houston for its environmentally responsible features.

Since 1996, the UT School of Nursing has doubled its undergraduate enrollment and now graduates more than 120 new nurses and more than 110 nurses with graduate degrees each year. 


University Center Tower
